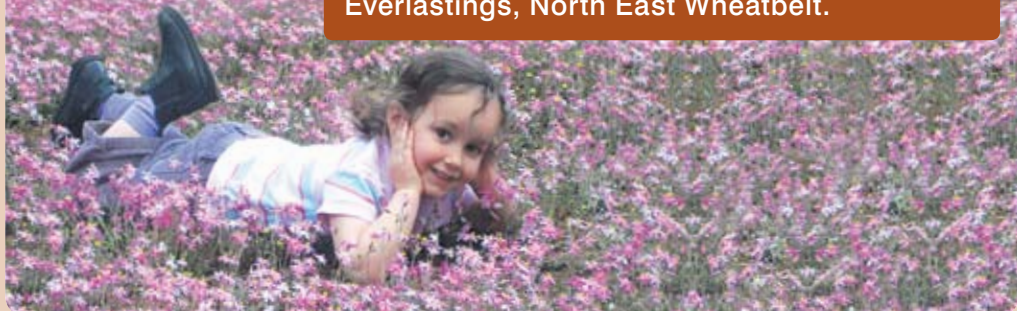


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# EXTRAORDINARY NORTH EAST WHEATBELT WILDFLOWERS NOW BLOOMING.

Everlastings, North East Wheatbelt.



**Wildflowers are now blooming across North East Wheatbelt towns and with great winter rains, the world's most spectacular wildflower show begins. Explore wide open spaces and green rolling hills, along the way enjoy country hospitality and meet friendly locals who will give you directions to specific wildflower locations and local attractions.**

**Dowerin - Minnivale:** At Tin Dog Creek Reserve there's an array of birdlife and flora. Take the gravel road for 8km past the wheat bins and explore historic Minnivale Cemetery where black toothbrush grevillea and verticordia are blooming.

**Mukinbudin - Mt Marshall:** At Bencubbin/Mukinbudin Rd see pityrodias & coppercups. Wattoning & Bonnie Rock Rds for hakea, grevillea, senna, wattle & damperia. Good rains ensure large white & yellow everlastings along Mouroubra Rd to Paynes Find. Native orchids including spider, donkey, snail usually found around shrubs at base of granite outcrops. On rocks you will find calytrix, hibbertia & kunzea. A number of bush flowers budding & wildflower seedling around Billyburning Rock, Chrimpy's Tank, Datjoin Well & Rock. Call in to the Community Resource Centre or Watson's Way B&B for a current wildflower update.



**Wyalkatchem:** Has some of the loveliest reserves, including Walk-A-Wyal Trail (crosses golf course) & Wyalkatchem Reserve all within walking distance from town & RV Friendly Caravan Park. Korrelocking Reserve is a 5min drive or 20min bike ride from town. In these reserves find rare orchids, sundew, everlastings and fauna including Echidnas, Dunnarts, Blue Breasted & Red-Capped Robins. Along Wyalkatchem North Rd to Cowcowing Reserve see the endangered Wyalkatchem foxglove, call into Wyalkatchem Visitor Centre for more info.

**Beacon:** Bush flowers budding & wildflower seedlings at rock and water catchment tank sites around Beacon, Billiburning Rock, Crimpy's Tank, Christies Tank, Datjoin Well & Rock.



**Trayning - Nungarin - Westonia:** Trayning, Billyacatting, Mangovine & Westonia have great botanical walks. See pink everlastings around Beringbooding Rock, Talgomine Reserve and Wilgoyne wheat bin. Along parts of the route find wattle, hakea & grevillea. Keep an eye for damp places near rocks where you may see insect eating plants (drosera).

**Koorda:** Has its very own Koorda Rose, call into the Shire Office for more info.

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
