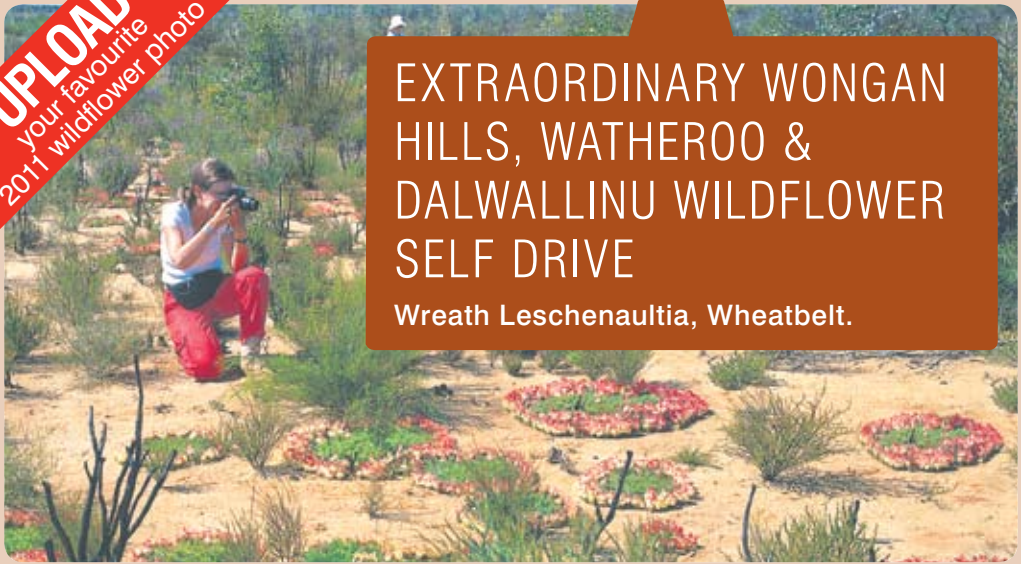

EXTRAORDINARY WONGAN HILLS, WATHEROO & DALWALLINU WILDFLOWER SELF DRIVE

Western Australia has the largest collection of wildflowers on earth, so hit the road and head for the extraordinary Wongan Hills, Watheroo and Dalwallinu regions.

Wongan, Dalli & Watheroo wildflower self drive itinerary

Wongan Hills - wildflowers out now including hakea, acacia and some orchids. Visit Mt O'Brien Lookout, Christmas Rock Walk Trail, Gathercole Nature Reserve, Wongan Hills Nature Reserve, Waddington-Wongan Rd to walk Mt Matilda Walk Trail. Drive past Elphin and Rogers Reserve each with many wonderful varieties.

Wongan Hills Events - Reynoldson Reserve Festival 11-13 Nov. Weekend of guided walks of Reynoldson Reserve with its 7 varieties of verticordia.

Dalwallinu - the region is renowned for its prolific species of wattles now flowering, but also has orchids and grevilleas. Damperia, hakea and pityrodia will continue to bloom over the next few months. Everlastings now blooming with carpets of pink and white at Wubin Rocks (6 kms north of Wubin) & Gibberding rest stop (25 kms north of Wubin).

See Yellow Pom Pom at Miamoon (17 kms west of Wubin). The famous Wreath Leschenaultia now appearing on Goodlands Rd (20 kms off Great Northern Hwy), will be spectacular mid-September.

Dalwallinu Events - Wattle Week Festival 10-17 Sep. Wubin Wildflower Display 15-18 Sep with 200 species of wildflowers on display.

Watheroo - Watheroo National Park has cats paw and rare endangered eucalyptus. Be sure to call into the Western Wildflower Farm with everlastings, blue hibiscus, kangaroo paws and much more. Free entry, open 6 days, Mon-Sat. For regular wildflower updates visit www.wildflowerswa.com.au
